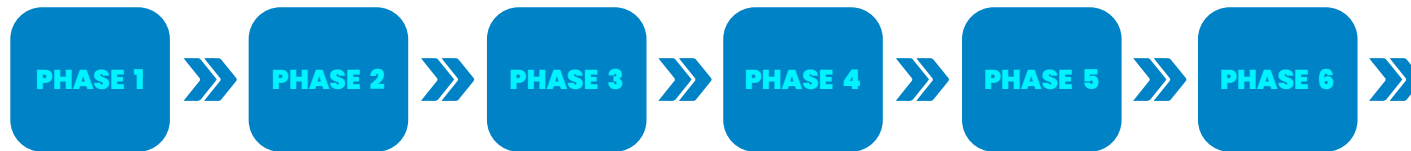


Reviews & Reflections: The Building Blocks for Special Events

As part of the **Community Change Pedagogy**

- each project is assigned a model and is divided into six phases.
- each phase is divided into a series of lessons.
- each lesson is formatted to conclude by engaging students in doing a lesson review and reflection.
 - For the review, students objectively restate the lesson's 1. question(s) 2. reference(s) 3. findings and 4. exercises
 - For the reflection, students subjectively critique the lesson by stating 1. what went well? 2. what didn't go well? And 3. what are some suggestions for improvement?
- the reviews and reflections of each lesson are documented to comprise a phase summary.
- the phase summaries combine to form the basis of the special events.
- special events are the culminating activity of a project that allow students to showcase what they learned.
 - Students showcase what they learned in a project by creatively expressing their phase summaries.
