## PROGRAM for Students in Temporary Housing

### VISION, MISSION & GOAL

CareerVisions, Ltd. (CVLTD) Pathway to Power (P2P) is a school-based intervention for 3rd – 12th grade students in temporary housing (STH) who attend elementary, middle and high schools throughout New York City.

CVLTD envisions P2P as a program that supports the survival and success of students in temporary housing through a community of caring peers and professionals who share their experience. The mission of P2P is to ensure and sustain students' achievement throughout their school years and beyond.

The goal of P2P is to strengthen STH students in three areas: academically, attendance and punctuality, and social emotionally.

P2P will pursue its vision, mission, and goal by being intentional about providing academic, attendance and social emotional learning (SEL) school-based services to students in temporary housing. This is a high need population that is often overlooked and underserved. Services will be delivered by P2P Facilitators who were previously members of this target group.

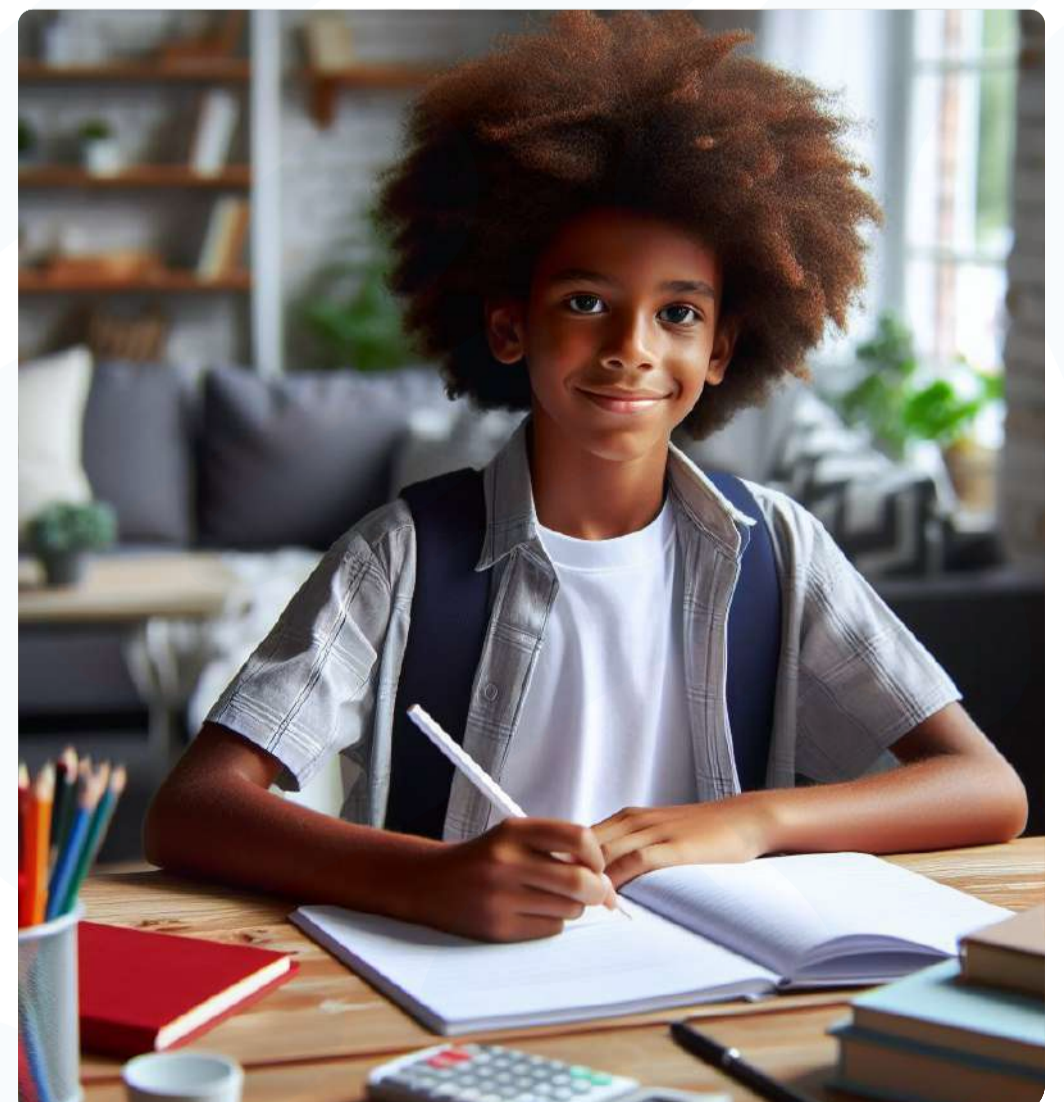
### SERVICES

P2P's services will consist of the following services:

**Academic:** connecting students to tutoring, homework help, and test prep resources.

**Attendance & Punctuality:** one-on-one guidance, as well as attendance home visits, wake-up calls and reminder texts.

**SEL:** academic/interest-based activities integrated with a choice of CVLTD's trademark approaches to career explorations, service learning, culinary arts, cultural education, financial literacy, and relationship education. For each approach, CVLTD's facilitators will use its trademark A.I.-powered generator "Teacher PAI" to create lessons that make any academic subject meaningful and useful in the real world of the students. Students will also participate in community action projects, field trips, and deliver presentations.





## PRICING

P2P can serve up to 15 6th – 12th grade students per cohort. Schools may have multiple P2P cohorts running concurrently or consecutively, based on their preference.
